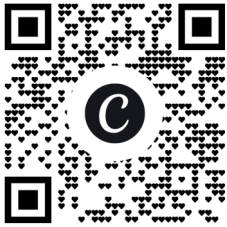

Let's not skip over an important part of our church's name and this month remember St. Cloud, the person whose name our city has appropriated. The following is taken from an Internet summary:

St. Cloud, also known as Clodoald, was born in 522 AD. He was the grandson of King Clovis I, the first Catholic ruler of what is now France, and the son of King Chlodomer of Orléans. His family was part of the Merovingian dynasty.

After the death of his father, Clodomir, in 524 AD, St. Cloud and his brothers were raised by their grandmother, St. Clotilde.

St. Cloud's uncles, Childebert and Clotaire, plotted to kill him and his brothers to consolidate power. While his brothers were murdered, St. Cloud escaped this fate.

St. Cloud chose to renounce his royal claims and live a life dedicated to God. He became a disciple of St. Séverin, living a life of solitude and prayer. Later, he founded a community of monks in Nogent, near Paris, which is now known as Saint-Cloud.

St. Cloud is venerated in both the Eastern Orthodox and Roman Catholic Churches and his feast day is celebrated on September 7. He is remembered for his commitment to faith and service, having turned away from the temptations of royalty to lead a life of humility and devotion.

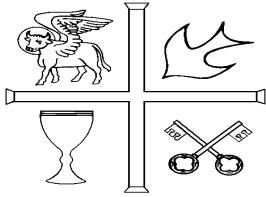

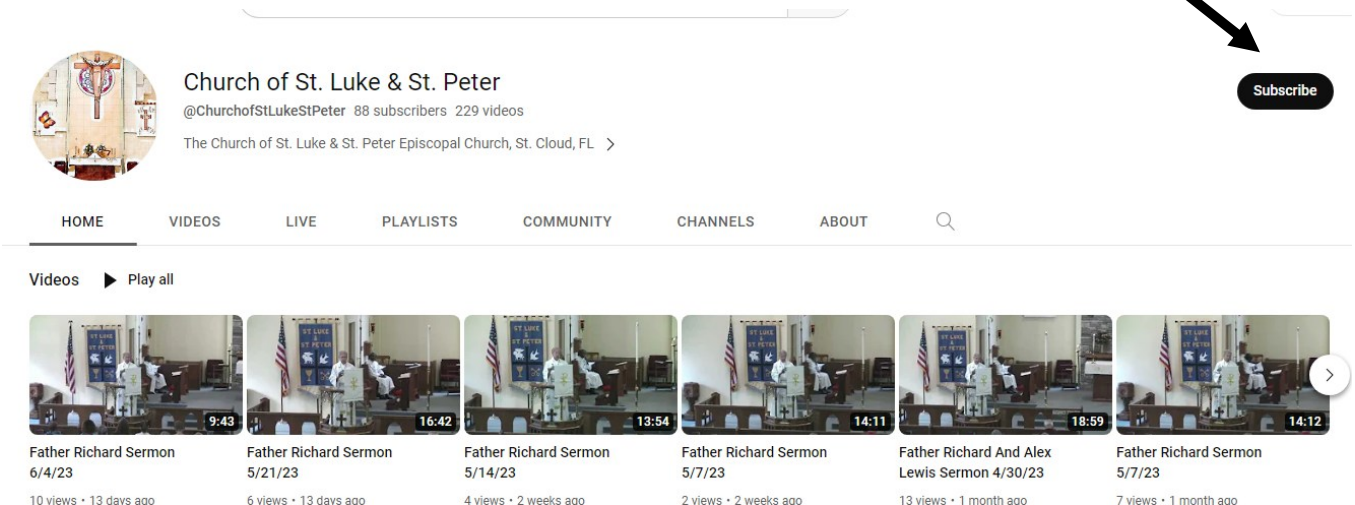
