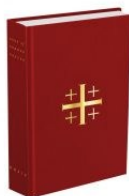

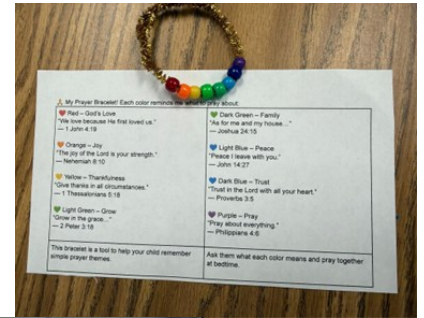

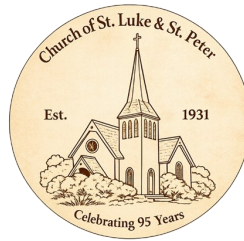


Spring is officially here, with new beginnings and fun times! The Youth Group did not do anything out of the ordinary, though that doesn't mean we didn't still have fun!

We look forward to celebrating this special milestone together!



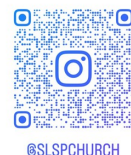

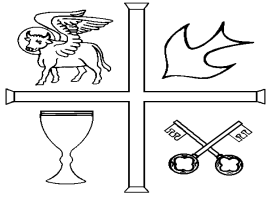

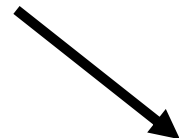
